
Altair Inspire Cast 2022.3 includes the following new features and enhancements.

New Meshing Strategy for Non-Conforming Mesh

Inspire Cast 2022.3 includes a new meshing strategy that:

- Reduces mesh requirements:
 - It is no longer necessary to perform geometric operations to detect contacts. Inspire Cast's new algorithm automatically detects and defines the connections between different components.
- Makes the mesh automation much more robust: Since it is not necessary to perform geometric operations and the mesh is now generated component by component, the simplified meshing strategy is much more robust.
- Solves most meshing challenges when analyzing a model with multiple components: For models with many components, connections between components are often complex and challenging to define geometrically. The new strategy supports non congruent meshes, thus automatically resolving this challenge.

This improvement does not affect how you use the product.



In-Application User Assistance


Inspire provides two types of user assistance. **Enhanced tooltips** appear when you hover over icons and other features. They describe what the tool does.



Workflow help appears when you select a tool that opens a guide bar or microdialog. The text prompts you what to do next.




